Fellows will receive a \$50K stipend, plus:

- (2) Experience representing an arts and/or culture organization dedicated to equity and community engagement
- (3) Recognition for advancing organizational structures, policies and SAN DIEGO AREA practices with inclusive decision-making.

Host Organizations will receive a \$35K grant, plus:

- (1) The tools, capacity, and knowledge to become an effective arts and cultural organization in the creative sector
- (2) Experience hosting a Fellow and piloting a program dedicated to equity and community engagement
- (3)Enhanced organization structures, policies, and practices which emphasize inclusive decision- making.
